Open to property owners / organisations for projects on any property in the Tasman catchment – Forcett through to the Peninsulas

Funding is available to supply native trees, shrubs and grasses for suitable revegetation projects in 2024.

Guards, stakes and weed mats are not available - you will need to provide these (or similar measures) to protect your plants from our charming local wildlife until they've established. A total of 2000 tubestock plants are available with a maximum allocation of 200 per applicant. Only plants native to south-east Tasmania will be supplied.

Plants will be supplied by Wildseed Tasmania in Sorell. If your application is approved, you will need to contact Andrew (0429 851 500) or Helenka (0438 318 797) to confirm the availability of your requested plants and to arrange a time to pick them up.

Applications will be assessed in March/April and the plants should be available from May. Applications will be accepted after March/April until all the plants are allocated.

The propagated plants are native to the area and a variety of species are being grown to suit a range of local habitats. Wildseed will try to supply your requested plants or will supply suitable alternatives. In the event suitable plants are not available in 2024 the supply may be rolled over for collection in 2025.
